



The displayed blue service dress uniform, with accoutrements, belonged to Technical Sergeant Louis Clever. TSgt Clever was a crewmember on EC-47Q, callsign CAP-72, shot down over Laos on 5 February 1969. His uniform was donated for display by his son, Paul Clever.
