Steps

1. Start at Welcome Center
2. Go southeast on Welcome Center (1 feet)
3. Turn right to stay on Welcome Center (2 feet)
4. Turn left on Sidewalk (69 feet)
5. Turn right to stay on Sidewalk (319 feet, 1 minute)
6. Turn left to stay on Sidewalk (28 feet)
7. Turn right to stay on Sidewalk (104 feet)
8. Turn left to stay on Sidewalk (4 feet)
9. Continue on EISENHOWER DR (14 feet)
10. Turn right to stay on EISENHOWER DR (72 feet)
11. Turn left at Cut-through/Grave Row to stay on EISENHOWER DR (3036 feet, 12 minutes)
12. Turn right on Grave Row (668 feet, 5 minutes)
13. Turn left on JESSUP DR (10 feet)
14. Turn right on Grave Row (18 feet)
15. Turn right to stay on Grave Row (46 feet)
16. Finish at Baron 52 on the left
