The 6994th Security Squadron (SS) held its 2021 reunion at the Downtown Holiday Inn, Mobile, AL from 26-28 Aug 2021. These veterans operated and maintained the airborne radio direction finding (ARDF) electronic equipment aboard the EC-47 aircraft deployed to 7 different locations within Southeast Asia during the Vietnam War. The 6994th SS reunion chairs organized a Vietnam War Commemorative Partner Program (CPP) ceremony to welcome home and pay tribute to 7 veterans and their families as part of the reunion activities. Attendees enjoyed tours of the Alabama Flight Works facility and the Bellingrath Gardens and Home. Everyone enjoyed a great pizza party on Friday night. The CPP pinning ceremony was held immediately after the banquet meal on Saturday. The squadron reunion leaders Rick Yeh and Rich Krejsa were joined by Joe Martin, co-manager of the EC-47 History Site, for the presentation of the lapel pins and certificates. A special CPP Gold Star lapel pin and certificate of appreciation were presented to the niece and grandnephew of one of the squadron members, Mike Stiglich. Sergeant Stiglich was killed in action during the war. The commemoration program included a declassified operations video as well as a video from the Commemoration library. The 6994th Security Squadron reunion received excellent planning support from the EC-47 History Site CPP... and the program was well received and appreciated by everyone in attendance. 
